## **DEPARTMENT REPORTS**

### **CITY ADMINISTRATOR**

CAO Bailey announced that nominations are now being accepted for the Gordon Johnson Award which is given out annually. The KY 16 Beautification Project will begin at the end of March and be completed by May 31, 2012. The contract was awarded to Paul Michels and Son. The plans have been submitted to the State for turn lanes on the new KY 16. The City is funding the lanes. Ms. Bailey has met with Sanitation District No. 1 in regards to the sewer overflow reduction project on Church Street. The Sanitation District has asked that the City complete some road repairs for this project. This project is ongoing and more information will be reported in the coming months. Thank you to Mike Robke for keeping the City Building open for Passport Day which was held on Saturday, March 10, 2012. Mr. Robke completed 29 passports in a 5 hour span. Our tornado relief efforts which we held March 5 – 12, 2012 had an overwhelming response from the community. All of the items collected were taken to a warehouse for distribution to the tornado victims of March 2, 2012. We sent employees and volunteers from the Police, Fire and Maintenance Departments to Piner to aid in the cleanup.

### **ADMINISTRATION**

Mr. Robke recognized Remke Markets for their donation to the Police and Fire Departments as part of their recyclable bag use program. For each customer that uses a recyclable bag a token is put into a slot for a specific organization, each token represents a dollar amount. \$95.00 was donated to the departments. Second delinquent tax notices have been sent out. A representative from KY Emergency Management was here to perform an audit for the generator grant and was pleased with our records. A request has been made for the final funding of this project. A request from Sams Club has been made for a \$1,500.00 grant to help with the Recreation Community Events.

Mayor Bell asked City Clerk Skirvin to report on the Horseshoe Casino Trip that is upcoming for the Taylored with Time Senior Group which will be held on May 30, 2012.

#### ENGINEERING

Ms. Bailey reported that Leland Drive work is being finalized and we are applying for a 50/50 split with Sanitation District No. 1.

#### FINANCE

Mayor Bell reported that the budget is in good shape. A financial summary can be found on our website.

#### FIRE

Commissioner Murray stated that the next Firehouse Dance will be held on March 16, 2012. The Fire Department was a back up for Piner after the tornado, we provided a pumper and a crew to assist with their calls during the search and rescue. Good work to the Fire Department on containing the fire on Wolf Road.

#### MAINTENANCE

Commissioner Kuehne stated that the department has been working on filling potholes. If anybody has a pothole that has been missed on their street, please contact the City offices to report it. Thank you to the Maintenance Department who helped with the relief efforts in Piner. Thank you also to Steffans Tool Crib for donating a wood chipper.

Marc Roden reported that the contractor will begin work on Reidlin Road on Friday and the road will be closed for approximately 2 weeks.

#### PARKS & RECREATION

Commissioner Kreimborg reported the Bunny Breakfast and Easter Egg Hunt will be held on Saturday, March 24<sup>th</sup>. In case of inclement weather that day, the Easter Egg Hunt has a rain date of Saturday, March 31<sup>st</sup>. On April 12<sup>th</sup> and continuing for 6 weeks, the City will host a Zumba class at the Fire Department from 6:00 – 7:00 p.m.


POLICE

We have 5 explorers in training led by Sergeant Spanyer and Officer Mills. Thank you to Sergeant Spanyer and Officer Mills for their work at the scene in Piner after a tornado hit on March 2, 2012. Thank you also to Officer Holstein who came in early to cover our City that day.

Mayor Bell stated that street renaming may be in the future with the construction of the new KY 16. A committee may need to be formed to review street names.

Mayor Bell recognized a boy scout that was in the audience. David Patton from McCowan Drive was at the meeting working on his Communications Badge.
