Mayor Bell expressed concerns about the traffic delays on Taylor Mill that will be caused by the Scott High School Homecoming Parade on October 5, 2012. Much discussion was held in regards to different routes and options. Commissioner Murray made a motion for Ms. Bailey to issue the parade permit base on the following stipulation: the parade is to be staged on Shadow Hill Court with the parade beginning on Mill Valley. The parade will proceed to Stone Hill then to Old Taylor Mill Road and finally end at Scott High School. Mayor Bell asked that each resident on Mill Valley be notified well in advance of this route. Commissioner Kuehne made a motion for the City of Taylor Mill to go on the record opposing the current process of collecting the 911 Emergency Dispatch Fee. The City of Taylor Mill is against the parcel assessment and the fee should go on the electric bill so that it is fair and everyone is paying the same fee. A written resolution should be delivered to the Kenton County Fiscal Court. Commissioner Murray made a second. The Assistant to the C.A.O. called roll.

PARKS & RECREATION



POLICE


