December 12, 2012**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm. Commissioner Kreimborg gave the invocation, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Mayor Bell. The City Clerk called the roll.

Commissioner Kuehne made a motion to accept the minutes from the November 14, 2012 Commission Meeting as submitted. Commissioner Murray made a second. All Commissioners were in favor.

**GUESTS**

Commissioner Reis presented Officer Joe Wilder with Governor's DUI Award.

Justin Booth, 716 Janet Drive was in attendance to present his request for a change in the Animal Ordinance to allow Urban Farming to include chickens. Presently the ordinance states that you cannot have any fowl within 500 feet of a dwelling. Mr. Booth stated reasons why urban gardens/chickens should be allowed in the City. Mayor Bell stated that the City would research the subject and check with other cities on what their ordinance states.

Jack Eversole, 70 Wilson Road was in attendance to ask that the Maintenance Department clean the side of the road from where it was bush hogged. Marc Roden stated that the County was hired to bush hog and the debris is not cleaned up after a project. Mr. Eversole stated that the culvert pipes are also clogged up due to debris and need to be cleaned out. Mayor Bell stated that the City will look at the existing Ordinances and talk to Marc Roden about what can be done. Mr. Eversole also stated that when Ed Meece, CAO, was with the City that Fairview was to be paved however it has not been done yet. Ms. Bailey said that to her knowledge the Commission at the time voted not to pave that road, but that the issue can be revisited. Ms. Bailey suggested that he attend a Municipal Road Aid Hearing in April or May when it will be decided which roads to repair with the next Fiscal Year Budget.

## **LEGISLATION**

Frank Wichmann gave a first reading of an Ordinance establishing regulations for motor vehicle traffic at the intersections of Blackstone Drive with Hughes Court and McCowan Drive and at the intersection of Sandman Drive and Old Taylor Mill Road in the City of Taylor Mill and providing penalties for the violation.

## **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

In previous meetings Downtown Taylor Mill Street Renaming Project had been discussed. Mayor Bell reported that the State has asked that the renaming be completed as soon as possible. Discussion was held on what streets were to be renamed. The final out resulted in the first Reading of an Ordinance to rename the street. The streets will be renamed as follows: Honey Drive will be renamed Sawmill Drive, Sandman (South) will be renamed Sunny Acres Lane, Honeysuckle will remain Honeysuckle, Old Taylor Mill will remain Old Taylor Mill, Sandman (North) will remain Sandman, Davis Drive will remain Davis Drive and Taylor Mill Road from Grand Avenue to the end of the city limits at the South end will be renamed Pride Parkway.
