The public hearing was called to order at 6:30 pm by Mayor Bell to discuss the 2014 Street Repair Schedule and receive public input.

Mayor Bell noted that Commissioner Kuehne would be late for the meeting due to attending the TANK board meeting. Mayor Bell noted there was a quorum present.

Jill Bailey stated we had many residents who had requested paving repairs to their streets. The following streets have had requests for street repairs: Saddlebrook, Arrowwood, Sage Hill, Rosewood and Sharon Drive.

Jill Bailey asked for the record to show that no public were present for the public hearing.

The city is working with the engineering group to have a schedule of repairs prepared for the next meeting in August. Mayor Bell asked if the city had to wait until the next meeting to take any action on the street repair schedule. Ms. Bailey replied that yes we would have to wait until after we had received bids on the proposed work and have a cost estimate for the project.

Ms. Bailey clarified which streets would be included Bayberry Court, Mill Stream Drive, Buttercup, Arrowwood, Saddlebrook, and Sage Hill Drive.

Discussion ensued regarding other streets that may need to be looked at. Commissioner Murray asked about the condition of Mill Stream and possibly black topping. Jill Bailey asked Marc Roden to contact CDS to determine if this item needed to be added.

Jill Bailey stated that this is not all the money that is allocated for the Municipal Road Aide Fund we are hoping to have some funds available for Mr. Roden to do some paving as we move forward.

Mayor Bell requested that the engineer look at High Top and to prepare an estimate. Jill Bailey asked Mr. Roden to contact CDS about this.

Jill Bailey stated that we had exchanged correspondence with the property owner today about Rosewood. This is a project we are still continuing to work on and hoping to have a resolution this year.

Commissioner Murray and Marc Roden stated that Colonial needed to be repaired.

Mayor Bell asked for the record to show that Commissioner Kuehne was now in attendance at 6:37 pm.

Mayor Bell discussed the condition of Wayman Branch Road. The Commissioners discussed the threshold a road must meet for emergency road assistance to kick in. Jill Bailey stated that we could apply for it and hopefully it will meet the threshold.

There was discussion of the disagreement of Wolf Road with the City of Covington.



Jill Bailey asked Marc Roden to discuss these roads further. Jill Bailey also alerted Angie Wright that the task of submitting these forms to the State to request the funding would be hers. There was discussion on the possible dates of slips for the road and the following roads: Old Taylor Mill and Mason.

Now is the time for comments from the public. There being no public present Commissioner Murray made a motion to adjourn the public hearing. Commissioner Reis made a second. All Commissioners were in favor
